LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest:

- Beyond all boundary hedges and fences and all white posts.
- Beyond the white posts on the left of the 1st hole, around the Practice Area, when playing the 1st hole only.
- Beyond the white posts on the left of the 7th hole, around the Greenkeepers' compound.

2. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

The young trees identified by having stakes are no play zone. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area, and it lies on or touches a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing the player **must** take relief under Rule 16.1f.

3. AERATION SLITS OR HOLES

If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration slit or hole

- Ball in General Area The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b
- Ball on the Putting Green The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d

4. ANIMAL HOOF DAMAGE

Damage that is clearly identifiable as having been caused by animal hoofs is ground under repair **only** when the ball lies in the hoof mark from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1 (But on the putting green, Rule 16.1 **does not** apply as such damage **may** be repaired under Rule 13.1)

5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Any area marked as ground under repair (**GUR**) or any area encircled by a white line: relief **may** be taken. Rule 16.1

INFORMATION

1. **Inclement Weather** If it becomes necessary to halt play due to thunder and lightning, or any other abnormal weather conditions, **a klaxon horn will sound one long blast. All play MUST cease immediately.** Players should then seek appropriate safe shelter.

2. **Distance Markers** Coloured markers set into the fairways are coded Red at 100 yards, Yellow at 150 yards and Blue at 200 yards **to the centre of the green.**

3. **Rakes in Bunkers** Please ensure that **all** of the rake is placed in the bunker in the direction of play.

4. **Priority of Green Staff** The Green Staff have priority on the Course at all times.

5. **The Red Stakes** Identifying the penalty areas to the left of the 4th hole and the left of the 5th hole extend to and coincide with the out of bounds edges.

6. **For Safety Purposes** Any player who hits a ball out of bounds on the 6th, 7th or 9th hole must report it to the Pro's Shop or the bar on leaving the course.
