



Dress Code

The Dress rules are for the guidance of Members and Visitors alike and are intended to be open, understandable as well as workable and to be consistent with the standards of dress considered acceptable at this Golf Club.

Members are expected to take personal responsibility for observing standards of dress that reflect well on themselves and the Club.

Visitors, visiting societies, visiting teams and those participating in open competitions are required to comply with these dress rules. It is up to Members to ensure that their individual guests are advised accordingly.

Please note our staff are empowered to judge whether an individual is acceptably dressed and take appropriate action. Failure to comply with this Dress Code will be brought to the attention of the Board.

On the Golf Course

Approved

Recognised, smart, golfing apparel and footwear must be worn at all times.

Men's golf shirts with collar, roll or turtle neck with long or short sleeves to be worn inside of shorts or Trousers.

Tailored knee length shorts may be worn with plain white socks of any style.

Ladies may also wear sleeveless golf shirts, which can be worn outside skirt, trousers or shorts.



Not Permitted

T-Shirts, vests, football, rugby or sports-style shirts, beach, football, swimming or combat shorts.

No denim, track, combat or camouflage trousers, no shell suits or trousers or shorts with patch pockets on the side.

Caps may only be worn with the peak to the front.

Trousers visibly tucked into socks.

Footwear without socks or non-plain white sports socks.

Golfers must change their clothing and footwear in the locker rooms only.



In the Club House

Approved

Clean, tidy smart casual clothes must be worn inside the clubhouse.

Casual tailored shirts must be worn inside the waistband in the clubhouse, (unless advertised otherwise for special events).

Jackets and ties or other formal attire must be worn for certain team meals, prize presentations and other functions, as designated or advertised.

The wearing of golf shorts by both men and women is permitted in the Clubhouse lounge area only (unless advertised otherwise for special events).

Any permitted type/style of shoe is accepted but must cover the foot and have an obvious sole. Sandals are allowed but must be worn with socks at all times.

Ladies are required to wear smart clothing suitable for the time and occasion.



Not Permitted

Outdoor wind and waterproof or wet and dirty clothing.

No denim, track, combat or camouflage trousers, no shell suits or trousers or shorts with patch pockets on the side.

No vests, T-shirts, football shirts, collarless shirts (except turtle or roll neck), or beach wear.

Flipflops and Trainers are prohibited in all areas including the patio and Golf Shoes are prohibited in the club house.

Caps, hats and visors must not be worn in the Club House.

Outside jackets should be removed and stored in the cloakroom.
